

# Find Duplicate Rows By Specific Columns

Consider a table, MyTable, with four columns: KeyCol, NameCol, IsActive, RowVersion. If you wanted to find all rows where NameCol and IsActive have the same values, you could do it as follows:

```
SELECT * FROM
  (SELECT NameCol, IsActive, COUNT(*) AS DupCount
   FROM MyTable
   GROUP BY NameCol, IsActive) AS ResultSet
WHERE ResultSet.DupCount > 1
```
